Piano

Pianos

or

oxen ~~oxes~~

⇒ The nouns that end in a consonant followed by y change into plural form by changing the y to i and then adding -es

city

cities

country

countries

monkey

~~monkeys~~ monkeys

⇒ The nouns that end in a vowel followed by y change into plural form simply by -addition of s

key

keys

⇒ To form the plural of a noun that ends in f or fe, we replace the f or fe with ves.

leaf

leaves

⇒ A few words do not follow the rule

chef chefs

⇒ some nouns have the same form in singular and plural

sheep	2 sheep
hair	2 hair
deer	2 deer
bison	2 bison

⇒ Irregular nouns —

Nouns that do not form plurals in the usual way

SINGULAR & PLURAL

A Noun can refer to one or more than one person, animal, place or thing.

Singular noun

A noun that names one person, animal, place or thing is called a singular noun.

Example: a boy, a cat, a house, a flower

Plural noun

A noun that names more than one person, animal, place or thing is called a plural noun.

Example: boys, cats, houses, flowers

⇒ Add -es to nouns that end in ch, sh, o, s, ss, x and z to get their plural forms.

Mango Mangoes

bus buses

Princess Princesses

fox foxes
