Definition

Word- a word is made up of a group of letters examples --chair, boy, brick,book etc.

Sentence-- a sentence is a group of words sentence should make complete sense when you read it or write it. examples -- that rabbit lives in a burrow.

Explanation

A complete sentence always begins with a capital letter(S) and ends with the full stop(.) Or an Exclamation Mark(!), question mark(?)

Ram writes a letter.

Does Ram write a letter?

What a letter!

A complete sentence has two parts-- Subject and predicate.

The subject is a word or a group of words that tells whom or what the sentence is about.

The predicate is a word or group of words that tells something about the subject.

Example-- Rahul(subject)eats fruits(predicate)
