





For eg. (i) we play (ii) They go (iii) You run etc.  
(iv) I sleep (v) I eat. (vi) I swim etc.

(B) Negative Sentences :- S + do not + V, + O. (or)  
S + does not + V, + O.

Singular Subject :- S + does not + V, + O.  
use 'does not' if the subject is singular  
& use 'do not' if the subject is Plural.

- e.g. (i) He does not go to the market.  
(ii) She does not read the newspaper.

Plural Subject :- use 'do not' with we, you, they etc.  
eg: (i) They do not like tea.

(ii) You do not work in the factory.

⇒ I को साथ do not करो, मैं प्रश्न करता हूँ।

(C) Interrogative Sentences :- Does + S + V, + O?  
DO + S + V, + O?

Singular Subject :- Does + S + V, + O?

- use 'Does' first of all  
eg: (i) Does he live in Bhopal?  
(ii) Does she drink tea?  
(iii) Does Hari play Hockey?

Plural Subject :-

- (i) use 'Do' first of all.  
e.g.:- (i) Do we go to Agra?  
(ii) Do you write a letter?  
(iii) Do they sing a song?

I को साथ दो करो  
के पास  
मैं प्रश्न करता हूँ।  
eg:- Do I know?  
Do I play etc.
