Q.1 Divide 20 toffee among 4 children.

Method-

$$20 - 4 = 16. \quad (1 \text{ times})$$

$$16 - 4 = 12. \quad (2 \text{ times})$$

$$12 - 4 = 8. \quad (3 \text{ times})$$

$$8 - 4 = 4. \quad (4 \text{ times})$$

$$4 - 4 = 0. \quad (5 \text{ times})$$

$$\text{So } 20 \div 4 = 5$$

Sol. Total no. Of flowers = 12

$$\text{Each girl get} = 12 \div 4$$

$$= 3$$
